## Free bone health screenings available at Christiana Care July 9

Wilmington, DE, June 29, 2016 – Christiana Care Health System will host free bone health screenings and consultations on Saturday, July 9, from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the John H. Ammon Medical Education Center on the Christiana Hospital campus. The local screenings are part of the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual National Bone Health event by American Bone Health called *Freedom from Fractures*. American Bone Health hopes to raise national awareness about the 2 million preventable fractures that occur annually.

"People who understand their risk of a fragility fracture can take steps to care for their bones and potentially prevent future fractures," said Timothy A. Manzone, M.D., JD, medical director, Nuclear Medicine at Christiana Care. "Reducing fracture risk can help individuals remain independent and strong for many years."

During the screening, participants learn how to reduce their risk of having a fracture through the bone health check-ups conducted by American Bone Health trained Peer Educators. The validated, web-based FORE Fracture Risk Calculator<sup>TM</sup> uses clinical factors that generates a graphic result of low, moderate or high risk. Given the results, the peer educators discuss a road map to better bone health.

The event is scheduled in 42 locations around the country.
